Designed to deliver financial aid to patients travelling to Halifax for cancer-related treatments, the cd sales and live concerts raised more than \$200,000.

## LEADERSHIP

In 2017, Charlie launched the **Charlie A'Court Scholarship for Excellence in Music** as a means of paying it forward to the next generation of musician and artists. Partnered with the Nova Scotia Department for Education and Early Childhood Development, each year CASEM awards \$500 to a Nova Scotian high school graduate who is continuing their music education in a post-secondary institution. In addition, CASEM is also the presenting sponsor for the **Portia White Youth Award** given out at the **African Nova Scotia Music Awards**.

Charlie also runs a grass-roots project called **Stringathon** whereby Charlie collects un-used guitar strings from local musicians and retailers and sorts them out to make complete sets of strings which are in turn donated to local schools and their band programs.
